

# Items to Bring

## Berkshire Middle School Traveling Classroom to Kentucky's Cave Country

### Required

Small Flashlights (2) w/ extra batteries  
Boots (inexpensive) w/ ankle support and deep tread (lug soles). **Must be approved by Mr. Phillips!**  
Rain Gear  
Old Clothes - long pants, socks, sweatshirt, jacket, leather work gloves  
Large heavy duty plastic garbage bag for wet and muddy clothes and boots  
Personal hygiene items  
Water bottle (empty pop bottle will do)  
Small fanny/waist pack to carry water bottle and flashlight

### Recommended

Toothbrush, toothpaste, floss  
Small pillow and light blanket for bus  
Pajamas (sweat pants and sweat shirts work well)  
Extra socks, underwear, shirts, shorts, and jeans (slacks with zip-off legs work well)  
Hat  
Extra shoes  
Small backpack/soft carry-on bag  
Sunscreen  
Vest with pockets for Mammoth Cave (no bags or packs of any kind allowed)  
Book to read

### Optional Items (Parent Discretion!)

Calling Card (Students will have access to phones and opportunities to make calls)  
Inexpensive Camera (s) (disposable recommended)  
Spending Money for souvenirs and snacks (Snacks will also be provided)  
Inexpensive Personal Audio Players  
Postcard Stamps w/ pen/pencil  
Snacks **without NUTS!!!**  
Knee pads  
Ear plugs  
Sunglasses  
Clip-on reading light for trip down/for motel room

### **Strongly Recommended!**

Label all items with your name!

Bring a book, audio book, music, or journal to pass the time.

### **Medications**

Placed in a ZipLoc bag and submitted with directions and completed forms to Mrs. Battle.

### **Luggage**

Only two pieces of luggage allowed! One should be a soft carry on bag that you will take with you on the bus. The other will be stowed in the luggage compartment. You will be expected to carry your own gear!

### **Prohibited Items**

Cell Phones, DVD Players, Videos, Texting Devices, Electronic Games; **Snacks with NUTS!!!** Drinks other than bottled spring water; Light sticks; Knives and other sharp objects.
